In 2002, the United Nations General Assembly permanently adopted September 21st as the International Day of Peace. On September 22 and 23, 2009, His Holiness the Dalai Lama visited Memphis, TN where he received the International Freedom Award from the National Civil Rights Museum. During his two day visit he gave a public talk on "Developing Peace and Harmony." Memphis political leaders declared September 22 and 23 Memphis Peace and Harmony Days.

Khenpo Gawang Rinpoche will be leading a three day peace and harmony retreat at Pema Karpo Meditation Center following the tradition of Tibetan Buddhism.
